## MEET OUR SPEAKER Monica Ashour, MTS, MHum



Monica Ashour makes the depth and breadth of Saint John Paul II's compelling Theology of the Body (TOB) accessible for all ages. She holds two master's degrees from the University of Dallas in Humanities and Theological Studies. She is an international speaker, former teacher of 25 years, author of 28 books, and President of the Theology of the Body Evangelization Team (TOBET).

Monica and her team recently finished TOBET's new educational program called *The BODY Matters*, for pre-school through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students, complete with lesson books and educator and parent guides. Her team of excellent writers and editors included last year's speaker, Alexis Mausolf (Joan Walker's daughter). *The BODY Matters* is now translated into Spanish and is being used in schools and faith formation programs throughout the United States, as well as in Australia, Canada, Colombia, and the Philippines.

Named one of the top 24 Catholic Women Speakers (catholic-link.org) and one of the top 6 Theology of the Body speakers to youth by the National Catholic Register, Monica seeks to bring people to Jesus Christ and His Body-Bride the Church. Currently, TOBET is developing a new video program to address sensitive topics such as transgenderism and homosexuality called, *My Body, My Identity: Discovering God's Design*.

In her spare time, Monica enjoys playing second base on her niece's and nephew's softball team and playing bridge.
